

# PRESENTATION

The purpose of a presentation is to help students develop the skills necessary for verbally communicating ideas in a succinct and engaging way.

The **time limit** for a presentation is very important. This will force students to practice delivery and develop the skill of distilling only the most important points.

The presentation has 3 components:

1. **Delivery:** should include clear enunciation and understandable pace, good eye contact, good body language, and strict adherence to the time limit.
2. **Audio/Visual:** text, figures, etc. are clearly presented and easy to understand.
3. **Content:** should be packaged as a logical sequence of ideas and only the most salient points should be addressed.
